Quick Reference Checklist - 2026

1 Separate Concrete from General Waste

Clean concrete and asphalt must be kept separate from wood, drywall, and mixed C&D debris. Mixed loads incur higher tipping fees and reduce recycling options.

2 Check Material for Contamination

Asphalt from pre-1990 commercial sites may contain coal tar. Concrete from industrial sites may have embedded contaminants. When in doubt, test before routing to a standard recycling facility.

3 Know Your Weight Limits

Concrete is very dense. A standard bin hits its practical weight limit at 2-3 yards of solid slab. Ask your provider for the per-tonne overage rate before loading heavy materials.

4 Route to a Recycling Facility

Clean concrete becomes recycled aggregate (RCA). Clean asphalt becomes reclaimed asphalt pavement (RAP). Confirm your provider routes separated loads to recycling, not landfill.
