

Toronto Bin Rental Cost Guide 2026

BIN SIZES AND PRICES (TORONTO 2026)

- * 4 Yard \$275 - \$350 Best for: small cleanouts, shed clearing
- * 6 Yard \$325 - \$400 Best for: bathroom renos, decluttering
- * 8 Yard \$350 - \$475 Best for: kitchen renos, flooring jobs
- * 14 Yard \$450 Best for: basement gut jobs, medium renos
- * 20 Yard \$525 Best for: full home renos, roofing
- * 30 Yard \$650 Best for: large demolition, new construction

WHAT AFFECTS YOUR TOTAL COST

- * Waste type: Mixed load costs more than single-material (clean) load
- * Weight overage: \$135/tonne beyond included tonnage limit
- * Rental duration: Standard 7 days; longer rental = extra daily charge
- * Street permit: \$50-\$150 from City of Toronto if bin goes on road
- * Same-day booking may add a small rush fee
- * Outlying GTA locations may have higher delivery fees

TIPS TO KEEP COSTS DOWN

- * Separate clean loads (concrete, soil, yard waste) to get lower tonne rate
- * Book bin + aggregate delivery together to save on delivery trips
- * Estimate volume first: length x width x height (in feet) divided by 27 = cubic yards
- * Fill the bin fully - unused space still costs the same base rate
- * Ask about mixed load vs clean load pricing before you book
