

The Construction Bin Rental Checklist

Size it, place it, permit it, and load it right, from Bins Toronto

Before you book

1 Estimate your debris volume

A few bags points to junk removal; a room or more points to a bin.

2 Pick a bin size

6 to 14 yards for most home renos; 20 to 40 yards for demo and roofing.

3 Confirm where it will sit

A driveway needs no permit; a road or boulevard needs a city permit first.

On delivery day

1 Lay plywood under the bin

Protects asphalt and interlock from the steel feet and the load.

2 Keep the path clear

The truck needs room to drop and later lift the container.

While you load

1 Load heavy material first

Spread weight evenly across the floor of the bin.

2 Stay below the fill line

An overfilled bin cannot be legally transported.

3 Keep hazardous waste out

No paint, solvents, batteries, propane, or electronics.
